

Ability to use Existing Application Requirements When an Application is Rejected/Refused

Effective November 3, 2017 when an application is rejected or refused, applicants may reuse the following documents when reapplying for the same Disposition Type, Purpose/Activity, and boundary as the previous application:

- File Number for Consultation (FNC)
- Landscape Analysis Tool (LAT) Report
- Supplement

If the Disposition Type, Purpose/Activity, and boundary are **not** the same as the previous application, a new FNC, LAT Report, and Supplement are required.

If the application is rejected or refused for a reason related to the application's FNC, LAT, or Supplement, the applicant will be required to address the issues in the document that led to the rejection/refusal.

For example, if an application is rejected or refused due to an incorrect LAT Report, a new LAT Report will be required to reapply, but the existing FNC and Supplement can be reused for the new application.
